

CASE-OF-THE-MONTH SUBMISSIONS

Thank you for your interest in submitting a unique case for the ISCD 'Case-of-the-Month'. To be certain that we capture all the necessary information, we have developed a standard format and ask that you complete all aspects of the format. Cases should **NOT** include Patient Health Information (PHI) and should fully comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations concerning patient health information and records.

Brief history

Minimum: age, ethnicity, gender, indication for scan, BMI

Optional: depending on the case, additional information may be useful. Consider:

Manufacturer and model of instrument used, software

Current or previous treatment

Significant risk factors

FRAX calculations – if include, must list risk factors used in calculation

Images – Minimum requirements:

DXA: photo and table for one site.

VFA: lateral image.

Body Composition: Image and one table as appropriate.

Additional sites, tables, other images, or imaging modalities encouraged but not required.

All graphics must be of high resolution (600 dpi or higher) and must be submitted as jpg, jpeg, gif or png images.

Questions – applicable to the case or for individuals to consider. Questions should be numbered for easy reference to answers.

Answers – listed by number. Refer to ISCD official positions where appropriate

Additional questions /answers – for individuals to consider (optional)

When appropriate: Other images (e.g. VFA, x-ray, CT etc)

Follow-up DXA's

Follow-up history

Teaching points: list main teaching points from the case, refer to ISCD official positions when appropriate
